



# High School SHORT COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

## Miscellaneous

### **Economics**

*Grades: 12*

*Credit: 0.5 (semester)/Fee: None*

*Prerequisite: US History I; Co-requisite: US History 2 or American Government*

This course is designed to provide students with a study of the U.S. economy and the principles of a market or free enterprise system. Students will analyze each sector of the economy and then evaluate the way they fit together to form the aggregate. The goal is for each student to clearly understand how our economy works and how changes in any one area of the economy affect the whole economy.

### **Driver Education**

*Grades:*

*Credit: 0.5 (semester)/Fee: \$350*

*Prerequisite: Student must be 15 years, 3 months of age*

The purpose of the course is to provide the student with crash avoidance and defensive driving skills within the thirty hours of classroom and six hours of driving time available through the class. The students must turn fifteen years and three months old within the first month of the course to be able to take the Colorado State Driving Permit Test.

### **Integrated English 1, 2, 3**

*Grades: 9, 10, 11*

*Credit: 1.0 (Full Year)/Fee:*

*Prerequisite: Must have administrative permission.*

The Integrated English courses are for students requiring an alternate presentation of subject material.

### **Office Assistant**

*Grades: 10, 11, 12*

*Credit: .25 (semester)/Fee: None*

*Prerequisite: Office approval required*

### **Teacher Assistant**

*Grades: 10, 11, 12*

*Credit: .25 (semester)/Fee: None*

*Prerequisite: Teacher approval required*

### **Equipment/Team Manager**

*Grades: 9, 10, 11, 12*

*Credit: .25/semester /Fee: None*

*Prerequisite: Coach approval required*

### **Athletic Trainer Assistant**

*Grades: 10, 11, 12*

*Credit: .25 (semester)/Fee: None*

*Prerequisite: Co-enrollment in Anatomy & Physiology. Certification in CPR and First Aid. Course instructor approval required.*

Students will learn basic taping techniques for preventing injuries as well as basic rehabilitation techniques for injuries. Students are required to work home athletic events as student trainers providing taping and basic first aid. Students in this course are strongly encouraged to be at least co-enrolled in Anatomy & Physiology. All student athletic trainers are required to be certified in both CPR and First Aid.
